Introducing Community Serving Kids

In January of 2023, we launched our Community Serving Kids program. Here, we team up with community partners and are able to deliver truckloads of much needed items to places such as underfunded schools, local food pantries, struggling communities, and nonprofits who serve kids facing hardships. Items delivered can be shampoo, soap, lotion, batteries, toys, cleaning supplies, hygiene kits, paper towels, toilet paper, and so much more. By year end, we had delivered over 163,000 pounds of products valued at over \$2 million! So many kids and their families now have access to essential items without having to worry about how they'll be able to afford it. We are so incredibly thrilled with the success of this program and we look forward to seeing it grow in 2024.

Our 2023 Annual Lemonade Stand was our hottest event yet, but that didn't stop the crowds from showing up! We had 70 stands set up all throughout Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, and Florida! 

Shortly thereafter, beds were delivered to kids on the waitlist. It was so heartwarming to know that over 150 kids were taken off of that waitlist and could enjoy a nice, warm bed; a luxury that all kids should have. We hope to do another bed build in the fall of this year!
